The Quito Road bridges project is a multi-jurisdiction project among the City of Saratoga, Town of Los Gatos and the Santa Clara Valley Water District. The project will replace two existing bridges on Quito Road on the border of Saratoga and Los Gatos. Both bridges cross over San Thomas Aquino Creek - just south and north of the intersection of Quito Road and Old Adobe Road. The current bridges were constructed in 1915 and do not meet current State design standards or seismic safety criteria for bridges.
