A. Funded Projects Reviewed:

Improvements to San Marcos Trail and scheduled site visit, cost may be less than projected;

Calabasas Creek Trail, we have half of funding, will there be access from residences?

B. Trail Naming – Sanborn Skyline proposed trail, recommend Saratoga to Sea, Saratoga to Skyline another possibility.

Anza Trail is moving forward with EIR. There is some mitigation. Drilling for bridges over the creek is taking place.

Segment 13 needs repair – estimate is high, should be evaluated, scope of work may be more than needed at this time.

Trees slated to be removed at Wildwood Park, oak in parking lot is ill, roots damaged by parking lot, dangerous situation for a busy area.

Mid-Penn Open Space and Saratoga may partner to purchase land next to Hakone.

Along Hwy. 9 on left side going up, there is an active moving slide. The up and down movement of the road is evidence of the creep.
