Sealed Bid for 2011 Saratoga Pavement Maintenance Program

Following the closure of the bid submittal period, bids will be publicly opened and read for performing work as follows:

Scope of Work

- Prepare streets for slurry seal, which include crack seal removal of striping, sweeping and clean as noted in specifications – Exhibit G to the Bid Documents
- Slurry seal list of streets below as noted in specifications - Exhibit G to the Bid Documents
- Replace striping in thermo plastic unless other wise specified. Use Caltrans standard specifications 2010 Section 37; subsection 37-2: Slurry Seals
- See attached street maps for limits of work - Exhibit H to the Bid Documents

List of streets to be slurry sealed:

1. Dehavilland Dr from Cox Ave to Cox Ave
2. Dehavilland Ct from Dehavilland Dr to End
3. Anza Ct from Dehiavilland Dr to End
4. Ravenwood Dr From Quito Rd to End
5. Marilyn Lane from Ravenwood Dr to End (at school driveway)
6. Marshall Lane from Quito Rd to Marilyn Lane
7. Horseshoe Dr from Saratoga-Los Gatos Rd to Saratoga-Los Gatos Rd
8. Scotland Dr from Saratoga Ave to Glen Brae Drive

Furnishing all labor, equipment, and performing all work necessary and incidental to the construction of the project known as **2011 Saratoga Pavement Maintenance Program**, according to drawings and specifications as prepared by **City of Saratoga** and according to the Contract Documents. The work to be done consists of supplying all labor, methods or processes, implements, tools, machinery, and equipment to install slurry seals, scrub seals, cape seals, striping and other work not specifically mentioned herein, but which may be required as directed by CITY or its designated representative.

CITY hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in regard to any contract entered into pursuant to this Invitation for Bid, Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE's) will be afforded full opportunity to submit Bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the basis of race, color, sex, national origin, in consideration for an award.

Project is to be completed within 45 calendar days from the date specified in the Notice to Proceed. The Contractor shall pay to the City of Saratoga the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) for each and every calendar day's delay in finishing the work in excess of the calendar day completion time.

Send requests for project drawings and specifications to City of Saratoga; 13777 Fruitvale Avenue; Saratoga, California 95070; Attn: Public Works Director.

All bids must be presented on the form appearing as Exhibit A-1 to the bidding documents.

Pursuant to California Labor Code Section 1771, the successful bidder and all subcontractors shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. Copies of such prevailing rate of per diem wages are available for view at the City of Saratoga Department of Public Works.

Pursuant to California Public Contract Code Section 22300, the Contractor may, at its option, choose to substitute securities for monies earned by the Contractor and retained by CITY to ensure the performance of the Contract.

Pursuant to California Public Contract Code Section 3300, City has determined that the Contractor shall possess a valid General Engineering Contractor License at the time that the bid is submitted. Failure to possess the specified license shall render the bid non-responsive.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a payment bond in the amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Price, as well as a faithful performance bond, in the amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Price. The bonds shall be on the forms included in the Contract Documents.

The successful bidder shall insure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against on the basis of age, color, race, national origin, ancestry, religion, sex, sexual preference, or marital status, and shall comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

CITY reserves the right to reject any and all bids, or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bid or in the bidding procedure, or to postpone the bid opening or award for good cause. No Bidder may withdraw its bid for a period of five calendar days after the date of opening of the bids. Each bidder will be notified of award of contract, if award is made.
