



- Lighted Crosswalks
 - Vickery Avenue
 - Massol Avenue

- Completed Fall 2008

- Austin Way Intersection Improvements

- Bicycle Lane at Los Gatos Boulevard

- Bicycle Detection at Intersections
 - Fruitvale Avenue
 - Quito Road
 - Santa Cruz Avenue

- Traffic Signal Video Detection System
 - Alberto Way
 - Los Gatos Boulevard

- Completed Fall 2012

SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

Phase II Bicycle Improvements

- Pedestrian Paths
 - Close Gaps and ADA Compliance
 - Aloha Avenue to Three Oaks Way
 - Grandview Avenue through Monte Sereno Town Limits
- Lighted Pedestrian Crossing with Overhead Ped Warning Sign
 - Three Oaks Way
- Overhead Pedestrian Warning Signs
 - Vickery Avenue
- Pedestrian Lighting
 - Carnelian Glen Court
 - Horseshoe Drive
 - Farwell Avenue
 - Three Oaks Way
- Schedule
 - Starts after Thanksgiving and Completed in Spring 2013



SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

Phase IV Pedestrian Improvements

- Pedestrian Paths
 - Close Gaps and ADA Compliance
 - Fruitvale Avenue to El Camino Grande
 - Daves Avenue to Greenwood Road

- Radar Feedback Signs
 - Greenwood Road

- Schedule
 - Currently in Design Development
 - Caltrans Encroachment Permit

Futures Phases


- Close Pedestrian Path Gaps between Phase II and IV
 - Three Oaks to Fruitvale Avenue
 - El Camino Grande to Daves Avenue
 - Greenwood Road to Grandview Avenue

- Lighted Pedestrian Crossing with Overhead Ped Warning Sign
 - Greenwood Road

- Radar Feedback Signs
