Old Business

1. Traffic Matrix #318

Issue: The City conducted a comprehensive traffic evaluation of the Arroyo De Arguello neighborhood in 2014. The City engineer made several traffic calming recommendations at various locations in the neighborhood to address concerns voiced by residents. At the March 2015 TSC meeting, the Commission reviewed the traffic calming possibilities and voted for the City to make changes at the rail crossing to improve safety. At that same meeting, the Commission asked that the item be brought back to the Commission for further discussion regarding the prioritization of the remaining traffic calming recommendations.

Issue: Request for restricted vehicle parking on Melinda Circle by Alex Pang.
