12/28	S3	Vandalism	Between 1:00 AM and 9:00 AM on 12/27, unknown suspect(s) used an unknown object to shatter the rear window of a vehicle parked in the 19000 block of De Havilland Drive. Nothing was taken from the vehicle. The total amount of damage was about \$1,000.
12/28	S6	Grand Theft	Between 2:11 PM and 2:55 PM, unknown suspect(s) took a laptop left unattended at the Saratoga Library on Saratoga Avenue for a total loss of about \$2,000.

12/31	S6	Possession of Stolen Property, Burglary Tools, and Controlled Substances for Sale, Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance, False Information to a Peace Officer, Driving with a Suspended License ARREST	At 2:35 AM, deputies stopped a motorist at Saratoga Los Gatos Road and Farwell Avenue for traffic violations. An investigation revealed the suspect driver and passenger were in possession of stolen property, stolen mail, fictitious checks, burglary tools and controlled substances for sale. The suspect passenger was also under the influence of a controlled substance and provided deputies with false identifying information, to avoid detection of an outstanding warrant. The suspect driver was also driving with a suspended driver's license. Both were arrested and booked into Main Jail.
12/31	S2	Residential Burglary	Between 6:40 PM and 9:00 PM, unknown suspect(s) entered a residence in the 20000 block of Herriman Avenue by breaking a rear sliding glass door and took jewelry for an unknown total loss.
