1/8	S6	Grand Theft, Possession of Controlled Substances for Sales, Stolen Property, Leaded Baton, Stun Gun, Tear Gas Weapon and Drug Paraphernalia, False Information to a Peace Officer ARREST	At 2:57 AM, deputies located two suspects near several ransacked vehicles in the area of Myren Drive and Portos Drive. An investigation revealed the suspects were in possession of property stolen from nearby vehicles. The suspect's vehicle was located containing additional stolen property, controlled substances for sales, a leaded baton, stun gun, tear gas weapon and drug paraphernalia. One of the suspects also provided deputies with false identifying information to avoid detection of several outstanding warrants. Both suspects were arrested and booked into Main Jail.
