1/11	S1	Identity Theft	Between 10/1 and 10/15, the victim received notifications that unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to obtain credit accounts and made fraudulent purchases on those accounts for a total loss of about \$2,800. The victim lives in Saratoga.
