1/18	S2	Possession of Stolen Property ARREST	At 7:37 AM, deputies stopped a bicyclist at Tricia Way and Regan Lane for a traffic violation. An investigation revealed the suspect was riding a stolen bicycle. The bike was returned to the victim and the suspect was cited and released.

The suspect(s) are unknown and at large.
