2/2	S2	Identity Theft	On 2/2, the victim received notification that unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to file a fraudulent tax return for 2015 for an unknown total loss. The victim lives in Saratoga.
2/2	S2	Residential Burglary	Between 9:00 AM and 3:30 PM, unknown suspect(s) entered a residence in the 20000 block of Blauer Drive by prying open a rear door and took jewelry and other unknown items for an unknown total loss.
2/2	S7	Possession of a Controlled Substance and Drug Paraphernalia ARREST	At 11:59 PM, deputies made contact with a pedestrian in the area of Quito Road and Aspesi Drive. An investigation revealed the suspect pedestrian was in possession of a controlled substance and drug paraphernalia, in violation of the suspect's parole. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
2/2	S9	Identity Theft	At 2:00 PM, the victim received a fraudulent e-mail from what looked to be the victim's banking institution. The e-mail contained a link claiming the victim needed to update personal information on the bank account. The victim clicked on the link and provided the information. Unknown suspect(s) then used the information to transfer funds out of the victim's bank account for a total loss of about \$8,800. The victim lives in Saratoga.
2/3	S2	Petty Theft	Between 9:30 AM and 10:00 AM on 1/30, unknown suspect(s) took a wallet from an unlocked vehicle parked in the 12000 block of Sumner Drive for a total loss of about \$40.
2/3	S3	DUI ARREST	At 10:51 PM, deputies stopped a motorist at Brockton Lane and Titus Avenue for a traffic violation. An investigation resulted in the arrest of the suspect driver for driving under the influence of alcohol. The suspect was booked into Main Jail.
2/5	S8	Non-Injury Hit and Run Collision	Occurred at 9:10 AM at Saratoga Avenue and Highway 85.
