5/9	S2	Possession of Drug Paraphernalia ARREST	At 8:20 AM, deputies stopped a bicyclist at Saratoga Sunnyvale Road and Pierce Road for a traffic violation. An investigation revealed the suspect bicyclist was in possession of drug paraphernalia. The suspect was cited and released.
5/9	S2	Residential Burglary	Between 9:55 AM and 4:40 PM, unknown suspect(s) entered a residence in the 20000 block of Glen Brae Drive through an unlocked rear door and took cash, jewelry, music equipment and silverware for a total loss of about \$8,900.
5/9	S8	Non-Injury Collision	Occurred at 3:24 PM at Saratoga Avenue and Vineyard Lane.
5/10	S1	Vandalism	Between 6:00 PM on 5/9 and 8:30 AM on 5/10, unknown suspect(s) used an unknown tool to open five separate locked mail boxes belonging to residences in the 12000 block of Pierce Road, damaging the mail boxes. The total amount of damage was about \$350.
5/10	S5	Possession of a Controlled Substance ARREST	At 12:09 AM, deputies stopped a motorist at Big Basin Way and Saratoga Los Gatos Road for a traffic violation. An investigation revealed the suspect driver was in possession of a controlled substance. The suspect was cited and released.

An investigation revealed the suspect passenger provided deputies with false identifying information to avoid detection of an outstanding warrant. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.

5/14	S2	Residential Burglary	Between 8:10 PM and 10:15 PM, unknown suspect(s) entered a residence in the 19000 block of Sea Gull Way through a doggie door into the garage then by kicking open a door leading into the house. It is unknown if anything was taken from the residence.
