



# Friendly tips from the City of Saratoga to keep your neighborhood beautiful



**Don't forget to put the toys away.** You can keep boats, RVs, and storage containers in the driveway for up to 5 consecutive days, and up to 18 days per calendar year. Consider keeping these items screened from view or at a secure storage facility.



**Stay trim!** Keeping weeds 12 inches or shorter keeps you property looking maintained and prevents potential for fire hazards.



**Take out the trash, and also put it back.** Trash and recycling containers can be taken out to the curb as early as noon the day before your scheduled pickup day and can be left out until noon the day after collection.



**Keep that fixer upper in the garage.** Inoperative vehicles or trailers, parts, or dismantled vehicles can be stored in the garage and out of view of neighbors.



**Recycle or donate unwanted items.** Find one of the many local organizations that accepts donations or recyclable materials instead of storing unwanted items in front of your home. **Contain Fido's enthusiasm.** Help maintain the peace and tranquility of your neighborhood by keeping family pets quiet between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. and limiting animal noise the rest of the day.
