| 6/20 | S2 | Residential Burglary | Between 5:00 AM on 6/16 and 12:20 AM on 6/20, unknown suspect(s) entered a residence in the 20000 block of Guava Court by breaking a rear sliding glass door and took foreign currency and jewelry for a total loss of about \$15,000. |
| 6/21 | S2 | Identity Theft, Mail Theft | Between 6/17 and 6/21, unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to access the victim's credit card account and made fraudulent charges. Upon learning of the charges, the victim cancelled the card and ordered a new one, which was taken from the victim's residence in the 12000 block of Saratoga Creek Drive shortly after being delivered for an unknown total loss. |
| 6/21 | S2 | Residential Burglary | Between 10:00 AM on 6/20 and 4:00 AM on 6/21, unknown suspect(s) entered a residence in the 20000 block of Granada Court by breaking a rear sliding glass door. It is unknown if anything was taken from the residence. |
| 6/21 | S8 | Possession of a Controlled Substance and Drug Paraphernalia ARREST | At 3:21 AM, deputies stopped a motorist at Quito Road and Bucknall Road for a traffic violation. An investigation revealed the suspect driver was in possession of a controlled substance and drug paraphernalia. The suspect was cited and released. |
| 6/21 | S8 | Possession and Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance ARREST | At 9:50 AM, deputies responded to a disturbance call at a residence in the 12000 block of Saratoga Avenue. An investigation resulted in the arrest of the suspect for being in possession and under the influence of a controlled substance. The suspect was booked into Main Jail. |
| 6/21 | S8 | Injury Collision | Occurred at 12:09 PM at Kosich Drive and Saratoga Avenue. |
| 6/21 | S1 | Non-Injury Hit and Run Collision | Occurred at 4:37 PM at Pierce Road and Bella Vina Court. |
| 6/21 | S2 | Vandalism | At 5:35 PM, the suspect used a metal bar to break the front windshield of a vehicle parked in the 20000 block of Williamsburg Lane. The total amount of damage was estimated to exceed \$400. The suspect is known and at large. |
| 6/25 | S1 | Stolen Vehicle, False ID to Peace Officer ARREST | At 12:01 PM, deputies made contact with the occupants of a vehicle parked at Prospect Road and Maria Lane for a traffic violation. An investigation revealed the vehicle was previously stolen from San Jose and the suspect passenger provided false identifying information to deputies. Both the suspect driver and passenger were arrested and booked into Main Jail. |
