6/27	S7	Non-Injury Collision	Occurred at 3:58 PM at Fruitvale Avenue and Allendale Avenue.

6/27	S7	Public Intoxication ARREST	At 6:45 PM, deputies responded to a disturbance call in the 18000 block of Casa Blanca Lane. An investigation revealed the suspect was unable to care for himself due to being under the influence of alcohol. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
