7/4	S8	Possession of Stolen Vehicle, Controlled Substance, Drug Paraphernalia and Stun-Gun, Hit and Run, Resisting Arrest, Unlicensed Driver ARREST	At 3:57 AM, deputies attempted to make a car stop on a stolen vehicle, but the suspect driver fled at high rates of speed and crashed into a tree in the area of Afton Avenue and Kevin Street. Further investigation revealed the suspect was also in possession of a controlled substance, drug paraphernalia and a stun-gun and was driving without a valid driver's license. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
