8/22	S2	Identity Theft	On 8/22, the victim discovered that unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to rent a house under the victim's identity for a total loss of about \$4,612. The victim lives in Saratoga.
8/22	S3	Non-Injury Collision	Occurred at 8:01 AM at Saratoga Avenue and Westview Drive.
8/22	S3	Theft by False Pretenses	At 12:15 PM, unknown suspect(s) telephoned the victim posing as a law enforcement officer, and told the victim to pay \$2,000 using prepaid cards to take care of a warrant for the victim's spouse, allegedly incurred for failing to appear for jury duty. The victim complied, but the suspect only received \$500 from the victim before the victim realized it was a scam. The victim lives in Saratoga.
8/23	S4	Theft by Credit Card	Between 8/3 and 8/15, unknown suspect(s) obtained the victim's credit card information using unknown means and made fraudulent charges for a total loss of about \$3,600. The victim lives in Saratoga.
8/23	S3	Assault and Battery with Serious Bodily Injury ARREST	At 12:25 PM, deputies were informed by school officials at Prospect High School on Prospect Road that two students were involved in a physical fight at the baseball field. The suspect punched the victim in the face, causing the victim to require stitches. The suspect was cited and released.
