An investigation revealed a passenger in the car was in possession of drug paraphernalia and had outstanding warrants. The suspect passenger was arrested and booked into Main Jail.

The suspect was booked into Main Jail.

Further investigation revealed the suspect passenger was also in possession of a controlled substance and drug paraphernalia and had an outstanding warrant. Both were arrested and booked into Main Jail.
