9/12	S2	Identity Theft	Between 9/6 and 9/11, the victim received multiple notifications indicating unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to apply for various lines of credit for an unknown total loss. The victim lives in Saratoga.
9/12	S2	Recovered Stolen Vehicle	At 1:34 PM, deputies recovered a vehicle, previously stolen from San Jose, in the 19000 block of Charters Court. The suspect(s) are unknown and at large.

Deputies made contact with the driver and passenger and an investigation revealed the suspect passenger provided deputies with false identifying information before fleeing the car stop on foot. Deputies were able to apprehend the suspect passenger a short distance away and further investigation revealed the suspects had committed multiple vehicle burglaries in the area and were in possession of a controlled substance for sales, drug paraphernalia, stolen property and burglary tools. Both were arrested and booked into Main Jail.
9/15	S4	Residential Burglary	Between 1:00 PM on 9/13 and 12:15 PM on 9/15, unknown suspect(s) entered a residence in the 20000 block of Verde Vista Lane by breaking a rear sliding glass door. It is unknown if anything was taken from the residence.
