11/14	S2	Damage to Utility Transmission Lines ARREST	At 12:00 PM, deputies responded to a civil dispute in the 20000 block of Herriman Avenue. An investigation revealed the suspect turned off the power to the victim's residence without permission and had an active warrant. The suspect was cited for the violation and was arrested and booked into Main Jail for the warrant.
