

Join in City of Saratoga Effort to Reduce Herbicides & Pesticides

The City of Saratoga and the West Valley Clean Water Program are asking residents to safely dispose of the harmful herbicides diazinon, chlorpyrifos, and chlorpyralid, by using the County's free Household Hazardous Waste Program.(408)299-7300

The City's Integrated Pest Management Plan and Policy does not allow the use of diazinon, chlorpyrifos, and chlorpyralid on City property. Use of these chemicals on private property is not regulated. These chemicals are known to be damaging to the environment and can be safely disposed of using the County's Household Hazardous Waste Program.

Many safer alternatives are available in the market. Please join the City's effort by removing these chemicals from your home to ensure they never enter the storm drains that lead to the bay.
