

# RODEO CREEK CROSSING

## Issues:

- Trail improvements could encourage railroad track trespassing hazard
- Length of bridge span over creek could be costly
- Creek as a natural resource and visual amenity is currently hidden
- Degraded creek water quality due to up-stream sewage leak presents potential water contact health hazard

## Potential Solutions:

- Provide separate trail bridge crossing with landscape and other site improvements (fencing/ railing) to direct trail users away from railroad bridge
- Provide new 50-ft. span steel truss bridge (per 2001 Feasibility Study - estimated cost \$75,000.00 ) -OR- utilize culvert (piped) crossing by filling approximately 45-ft. to the west to extend the existing railroad culvert
- Provide creek overlook at bridge approaches with selected pruning of existing vegetation
- Discourage creekside activity until sewage leak is repaired and water quality is up-graded
