RE: Re-introduction of Dogs On-leash Access at Sanborn County Park

The Santa Clara County Parks Department concluded additional environmental analysis for the Trails Master Plan's recommendations for the existing and proposed trail system within Sanborn County Park. On October 21, 2008, the Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors adopted the findings of the Expanded Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration and approved the project. With the Board's final approval of the Trails Master Plan project, the Parks Department on February 1, 2009 is able to re-introduce dogs on-leash access (on a 6-foot leash or less in length) to all trails within Sanborn Park, with the exception of two trails that lead into Castle Rock State Park.

Dogs on-leash access is not permitted on the Skyline Trail north of the Summit Rock parking lot to the Castle Rock State Park boundary, and on the Connector Trail north of the Indian Rock parking area that connects the Skyline Trail to the Castle Rock State Park parking lot.

In accordance to [Section B14-34.1. Pets in Parks Ordinance](#), the County Parks Department will patrol and enforce dogs on-leash access within Sanborn County Park.
