POINTS OF INFORMATION

- ❖ Phase II Safety Improvement Project along Highway 9 within Saratoga, Monte Sereno and Los Gatos
 - Pedestrian Path to Close Gaps, ADA compliance and Additional Crossings
 - Aloha Avenue to Los Gatos Town Limits
- ❖ Phase III Austin Way Intersection Improvement Project
 - Austin Way Intersection Modifications
 - Bike Detection at Signalized Intersections
 - Phase I Bike Lane Completion at Los Gatos Boulevard
- ❖ Phase IV Improvement Project along Highway 9 within Saratoga, Monte Sereno and Los Gatos
 - Pedestrian Path and Crossing to Complete Improvements from Phase II
 - Oak Place and Fruitvale Avenue to Greenwood Road
- ❖ Projects will require Caltrans Approval via an Encroachment Permit
- ❖ Improvements to be Implemented as Permitted by Funding Availability

CONSTRUCTION FUNDING

- ❖ \$900,000 from Construction from the Highway Safety Improvement Program
- ❖ \$462,000 from Proposition 116
- ❖ \$20,000 from Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority
- ❖ \$20,000 from Santa Clara County
- ❖ \$900,000 from Highway Safety Improvement Program (second grant)
- ❖ Required Local Match
