




Village Sign District

Building Signs


- * The aggregate area of all building signs shall not exceed ½ SF of area for each lineal foot of frontage, or 40 square feet, whichever is less
- * An additional 6 SF is allowed if the business has a projecting sign
- * No projecting sign shall exceed 10 SF in area and the bottom of the sign shall be at least 7 feet above grade (see graphic 1)
- * One permanent building sign, up to 2 SF in area, is allowed over each additional entrance to the building




Graphic 1: Projecting Signs (example only, not to scale)

Free-Standing Sign One permanent free-standing sign per lot:

- * **If the lot has 4 or fewer businesses**, the sign shall only be a pole sign and shall not exceed 9 SF in area or 10 feet in height (see graphic 2)
- * **If the lot has 5 or more businesses**, the sign shall only be a monument sign and shall not exceed 14 SF in area, plus one (1) additional square foot of area for each additional use over 5 uses. The sign shall not exceed 6.5 feet in height (graphic 3)

Temporary Sign (No more than *one* of the following may be displayed at any one time. Choose *either* a banner or A-frame)

Banner:

- Only allowed on a building
- Not to exceed 10 SF in area
- Constructed of durable all-weather fabric or synthetic material
- Not to be displayed at least 180 days per calendar year
- Cannot be displayed more than 30 consecutive days

Free-standing sign (e.g., A-frame):

- Located within 10 feet from primary entrance to the building
- Not to exceed 6 SF in area and 4 feet in height
- Constructed of durable all-weather wood, metal, and/or blackboard
- Not to be affixed to any tree or structure
- Only to be displayed when the business is open

- Not located within 10 feet of another temporary sign for another business
- Not to be illuminated. Not to include balloons, ribbons, streamers, or other attention-getting devices
- Not to be located on any median, street, or travel lane, or upon any sidewalk where it impedes pedestrian travel

Electronic Sign (e.g., neon or L.E.D.)

- Not to exceed 2 SF in area
- No more than two solid colors.
- Not to be illuminated when the business is closed.
- Not to flash or be composed of a changeable message.
- Counts towards maximum building sign or window sign allowance

Window Sign

- Not to exceed 25% of window area
