



# Miscellaneous Signs

## **Temporary signs in residential districts** (e.g., open house signs):

- Maximum area = 2 sf
- Maximum height = 3 feet
- Maximum two signs per intersection
- Only allowed between dawn and dusk
- No balloons, ribbons, streamers, or other attention-getting devices
- Cannot be in any median, street, travel lane or sidewalk (*can't block pedestrians*)
- Requires permission of the property owner

## **Temporary non-commercial signs** (e.g., election signs):

- Cannot be an advertising sign
- Maximum area = 4 SF
- Maximum height = 4 feet
- Maximum 1/2 inch thick
- Maximum 75 cumulative days within a one-year period
- No illumination
- Requires permission of the property owner

## **Temporary construction signs**

- Maximum area = 15 SF
- The sign shall be located on the same lot as the active construction project
- No illumination
- One sign may be freestanding, but in such case shall not exceed six feet in height
- One sign may be located on a construction fence
