### SITE VISIT AGENDA:

**Application FER19-0001; 12452 Miller Avenue (386-29-030); Daphanie Lin** – The applicant requests approval of a Fence Exception to install a 6 foot tall solid wood fence to be constructed within a 25 foot exterior side setback area where the maximum fence height is limited to 3 feet. The fence would be setback between 3 feet and 6 ½ feet from the exterior side property line and would replace the previously constructed non-conforming solid wood fence in approximately the same location.
