3/25	S9	Identity Theft	On 3/13, the victim received information indicating unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to access the victim's bank account, withdrew about \$25 and attempted to open a new bank account. The victim lives in Saratoga.
3/25	S4	Mail Theft	Between 11:00 AM on 3/23 and 10:53 AM on 3/25, unknown suspect(s) took mail from the mailboxes of multiple residences in the area of Pierce Road and Masson Court for an unknown total loss.

An investigation revealed the suspect was unable to care for himself due to being under the influence of alcohol. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.

3/30	S6	Attempted Residential Burglary, Vandalism	At 8:14 PM, deputies responded to an in-progress burglary call at a residence in the 20000 block of Spaich Court. An investigation revealed unknown suspects attempted to enter the residence by prying at a door, causing damage, but were unable to gain access. The total amount of damage was about \$1,500.
3/30	S8	Reckless Evading, DUI, Resisting Arrest, Minor in Possession of Open Container, Unlicensed Driver, False ID to Peace Officer ARREST	At 9:15 PM, deputies observed a vehicle with expired registration in the area of Cox and Saratoga Avenues and attempted to stop the motorist, but the suspect driver did not yield and recklessly evaded. The suspect eventually stopped, but did not follow commands and resisted deputies. An investigation revealed the suspect was driving under the influence of alcohol and drugs, had an open container of alcohol in the vehicle, was driving without a valid driver's license and provided deputies with false identifying information likely to avoid detection of the suspect's outstanding warrant. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
3/31	S6	Petty Theft	Between 7:00 AM on 3/29 and 4:00 PM on 3/31, unknown suspect(s) took an unsecured bicycle from a bike rack at Redwood Middle School on Fruitvale Avenue for a total loss of about \$300.
3/31	S1	Vandalism	At 6:30 PM, deputies responded to a disturbance call at Saratoga Sunnyvale Road and Cox Avenue. An investigation revealed the suspect jumped onto the hood of the victim's vehicle, causing damage. The total amount of damage was about \$2,000. The case will be submitted to the District Attorney's Office for DA review.
3/31	S9	Under the Influence and Possession of a Controlled Substance and Drug Paraphernalia ARREST	At 9:35 PM, deputies stopped a bicyclist at Quito Road and Allendale Avenue for a traffic violation. An investigation revealed the suspect bicyclist was under the influence of a controlled substance and in possession of Methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
