8/31	S2	Identity Theft	Between 8/1 and 8/27, unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information and attempted to obtain unemployment benefits. The suspect(s) did not obtain the benefits and the victim did not incur any financial loss. The victim lives in Saratoga.
8/31	S2	Theft by Credit Card	On 8/26, unknown suspect(s) used the victim's credit card information to make a fraudulent purchase online for a total loss of about \$202. The victim lives in Saratoga.
8/31	S1	Identity Theft	On 8/31, the victim received information indicating unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to open two credit accounts and conducted fraudulent transactions using the accounts for a total loss of about \$9,400. The victim lives in Saratoga.
9/1	S2	Identity Theft	On 9/1, the victim received information indicating unknown suspect(s) used the victim's personal information to apply for unemployment benefits for an unknown total loss. The victim lives in Saratoga.
9/1	S3	Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Controlled Substances for Sales, Unlicensed Driver, Proof of Insurance ARREST	At 12:58 PM, deputies stopped a motorist in the area of Prospect Road and Saratoga Avenue for a traffic violation. An investigation revealed the suspect driver was in possession of Methamphetamine for sales and was driving without a valid license nor proof of insurance, in violation of the suspect's post release community supervision terms. Further investigation revealed the suspect passenger was also in possession of Methamphetamine, in addition to drug paraphernalia. The suspect driver was arrested and booked into Main Jail, while the suspect passenger was cited and released.
9/1	S4	Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance ARREST	At 7:17 PM, deputies responded to a disturbance call at a residence in the 14000 block of Masson Court. An investigation revealed the suspect was under the influence of a controlled substance. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
9/2	S8	Possession of a Controlled Substance, Drug Paraphernalia and Misappropriated Property, Suspended DL ARREST	At 1:05 AM, deputies stopped a motorist in the area of Saratoga Avenue and Lawrence Expressway for a traffic violation. An investigation revealed the suspect was driving with a suspended license and was in possession of Methamphetamine, drug paraphernalia and property not belonging to the suspect, in violation of the suspect's probation terms. The suspect was cited and released.
9/3	S2	Theft by False Pretenses, Check Fraud	Between 7/1 and 9/3, unknown suspect(s) mailed the victim a check supposedly for catering services, claimed thereafter to have overpaid and requested the victim return the over payment via direct money wire, to which the victim complied before learning the check was forged and fraudulent for a total loss of about \$6,915. The victim lives in Saratoga.

9/3	S4	Stolen Vehicle, Reckless Evading, Possession of a Controlled Substance, Drug Paraphernalia and Stolen Property, DUI, Resist Arrest ARREST	At 3:12 AM, deputies attempted to stop a motorist at Big Basin Way and Springer Avenue for a traffic violation, but the suspect driver did not yield and recklessly evaded. The vehicle was eventually stopped, and the suspect was detained through use of a K9 unit. An investigation revealed the suspect was driving a vehicle previously stolen from Palo Alto, with license plates stolen from Cupertino. Further investigation revealed the suspect was driving under the influence of alcohol and drugs and was in possession of Methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
9/4	S8	Commercial Burglary	At 4:45 AM, an unknown suspect used a hammer to break a glass door and entered the Mobil gas station on Saratoga Avenue. The suspect took cigarettes for an unknown total loss.
