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1) INTRODUCTION

Mr. Michael Sneper (the Client) engaged Phase-1 Environmental Services (Phase-1 ES) to conduct a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) of the property consisting of two adjoining vacant parcels (APN's 389-06-20 & 21), located just south of the intersection of Cox Avenue and Saratoga Creek Drive, in the City of Saratoga, County of Santa Clara, California, subsequently referred to in this report as the "Property". This assessment was prepared in general accordance with the American Society of Testing and Materials (ASTM) Standard Practice for Environmental Site Assessments: Phase I Environmental Site Assessment Process (ASTM Designation: E-1527-13).

1.1) Purpose

The purpose of the Phase I ESA was to identify, to the extent feasible, recognized environmental conditions (REC's) in connection with the property. This assessment included a site reconnaissance as well as research of past studies performed on the Property, interviews with representatives of the occupants and property management, and research of various available environmental databases and agencies.

1.2) Scope of Services

The Scope of Services for the performance of this Phase I ESA included the following tasks:

- On-site visual reconnaissance of the Property to evaluate on-site activities in respect to hazardous materials use, storage and disposal activities.
- On-site visual survey of the current uses of the immediately adjacent sites, and surrounding area.
- Review of selected historic documentation for the Property to determine what activities have occurred at the subject site since the Property's first developed use.
- Review of reasonably ascertainable regulatory agency files concerning hazardous material use, storage and disposal at the Property and at adjacent and surrounding sites.
- Acquisition and detailed professional review of a current environmental sites radius report (MapHazardsPro Radius Report).
- Preparation of this report in general accordance with the document entitled *Standard Practice for Environmental Site Assessments: Phase I Environmental Site Assessment Process* (The American Society for Testing and Materials [ASTM], Designation E 1527-13).
- Interviews with available Property contacts, regulatory officials and personnel associated with the subject and adjoining properties.

1.3) Deviations

No deviations from the recommended scope of ASTM Standard E 1527-13 were required as part of this Phase I Environmental Assessment.

1.4) Significant Assumptions

While this report provides an overview of potential environmental concerns, both past and present, the environmental assessment is limited by the availability of information at the time of the assessment. It is

possible that unreported disposal of waste or illegal activities impairing the environmental status of the Property may have occurred which could not be identified. The conclusions and recommendations regarding environmental conditions that are presented in this report are based on a scope of work authorized by the Client. Note, however, that virtually no scope of work, no matter how exhaustive, can identify all contaminants or all conditions above and below ground.

2) EXECUTIVE SUMMARY, FINDINGS, OPINIONS, AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Property is located in an area of primarily Residential and Commercial properties about 150 feet to the south of the intersection of Cox Avenue and Saratoga Creek Drive, in the City of Saratoga, California. Its zoning is PA (Professional and Administrative). The Property consists of two adjoining parcels, Assessor's Parcel Numbers (APNs) 389-06-020 and 389-06-021. The lot size of parcel -020 is approximately 0.62 acres (net), and the -021 parcel is approximately 0.46 acres (net). Both parcels are vacant, undeveloped land. In segments of this ESA document, we will refer to the -020 parcel as "Lot 1", and the -021 parcel as "Lot 2".

A Site Vicinity Map and Property Site Plan are attached to this report as **Figures 1 and 2**, respectively.

The Property itself is not listed on any environmental regulatory agency database – past or present.

There are 2 sites within a mile of the Property that are on the CSL (Contaminated Sites) List. One of these cases is "Inactive", and the other a "Closed" case. They are both more than 4,800 ft. from the Property. Neither is of any significant environmental concern or liability to the Property.

There is 1 LUST (Leaking Underground Storage Tank) cases within ½ mile of the Property. This case is Closed, and of no environmental concern.

There is 1 site within 1/8 mile of the Property on the HAZMAT database. Hazmat sites either store or have been involved in hazardous materials incidents. This particular case is a surgery center about 350 ft. to the southeast that uses hazardous materials. No violations were noted. There are 22 HAZNET sites and 7 small or large quantity GENERATORS of hazardous materials within 1/8 mile of the Property. These sites have either disposed of (HAZNET) hazardous wastes or currently generate them (GENERATOR). No violations were noted. These are not of any environmental concern to the Property.

Property photographs can be viewed in **Appendix A**.

The Property site inspection found no areas of chemically stained soils, distressed vegetation, or any signs of past or present hazardous materials usage, storage, or disposal anywhere on the Property.

Historic topographical maps show and depict the Property as an orchard in 1948, 1953, and 1961. Organochlorine Pesticides (OCPs) were first introduced into California's agricultural operations in 1944, and reached peak usage in the 1960's. In 1974, the use of DDT was banned, and the elimination of the remaining OCPs quickly followed. These hazardous and persistent pesticides and heavy metals were commonly used in agricultural operations during the time period the Property existed as an orchard. It is our understanding that the Property is being developed for sensitive-receptor occupancy. As such, the near surface soils should be sampled and tested in accordance with the California DTSC guidelines for previous agricultural properties. Based on the size of the Property, a total of at least 4 discrete samples should be collected from 0-6" below grade surface, and at a minimum, analyzed for OCPs and Arsenic.

This Phase I study has found no other areas of Recognized Environmental Conditions (RECs) associated with this Property.

3) PROPERTY DESCRIPTION, LOCATION AND LEGAL DESCRIPTION

The Property is located in an area of primarily Residential and Commercial properties beginning about 150 feet to the south of the intersection of Cox Avenue and Saratoga Creek Drive, in the City of Saratoga, County of Santa Clara, State of California. Its zoning is PA (Professional and Administrative). The Property consists of two adjoining parcels, Assessor's Parcel Numbers (APNs) 389-06-020 and 389-06-021. The lot size of parcel -020 is approximately 0.62 acres (net), and the -021 parcel approximately 0.46 acres (net). Both parcels are vacant, undeveloped land.

A Site Vicinity Map Property Site Plan, and Parcel Maps are attached to this report as **Figures 1, 2, and 3** - respectively.

4) SITE AND VICINITY DESCRIPTION AND GENERAL CHARACTERISTICS

4.1) Topographic Map Review

The Property is located at an elevation of approximately 300 feet above mean sea level (U.S. Geological Survey "Cupertino, CA MRC: 37122C1 - 7.5 Minute Topographic Quadrangle). The area of the Property is

relatively flat – sloping slightly from southwest to northeast. Regionally, the general topographic slope of the area is to the northeast. The Topographical Map Overview is attached as **Figure 5**.

4.2) Hydrogeologic Review

Santa Clara Valley Groundwater Basin, Santa Clara Subbasin

- Groundwater Basin Number: 2-9.02
- County: Santa Clara
- Surface Area: 153,600 acres (240 square miles)

Basin Boundaries and Hydrology

The Santa Clara subbasin occupies a structural trough parallel to the northwest trending Coast Ranges. The Diablo Range bounds it on the west and the Santa Cruz Mountains form the basin boundary on the east. It extends from the northern border of Santa Clara County to the groundwater divide near the town of Morgan Hill. The dominant geohydrologic feature is a large inland valley (Fio and Leighton 1995). The valley is drained to the north by tributaries to San Francisco Bay including Coyote Creek, the Guadalupe River, and Los Gatos Creek. Annual precipitation for the Santa Clara basin ranges from less than 16 inches in the valley to more than 28 inches in the upland areas.

Hydrogeologic Information

Water Bearing Formations

The water bearing formations of the Santa Clara subbasin include Pliocene to Holocene age continental deposits of unconsolidated to semi-consolidated gravel, sand, silt and clay. Two members form this group, the Santa Clara Formation of Plio-Pleistocene age and the younger alluvium of Pleistocene to Holocene age (DWR 1975). Lithologic similarities make distinction between these two units difficult based on available well data. The combined thickness of these two units probably exceeds 1500 feet (DWR 1967).

Groundwater Level Trends

Historically, since the early 1900s through the mid-1960's water level declines from groundwater pumpage have induced subsidence in the Santa Clara subbasin and caused degradation of the aquifer adjacent to the bay from saltwater intrusion. Prior to importation of surface water via the Hetch Hetchy Aqueduct and South Bay Aqueduct and the introduction of an artificial recharge program water levels declined more than 200 feet in the Santa Clara Valley (Poland and Ireland 1988). Groundwater levels have generally increased since 1965 as a result of increase in recharge and decreases in pumpage (Fio and Leighton 1995). Current hydrographs of index wells within the subbasin maintained by Santa Clara Valley Water District support this trend (www.scvwd.dst.ca/gwuse/gwmimap.htm, 2001).

According to FEMA, the majority of Lot 1 (the “net” area) and all of Lot 2 are in a Flood Zone X – an area of minimal flood hazard. A small portion of the gross area of Lot 1 on its western-most side is the Saratoga Creek, which is in a flood zone A. No areas of potential wetlands were observed on the site during the inspection.

4.3) Current Use and Occupancy of the Property

The Property is vacant undeveloped land.

4.4) Description of Structures and Property Improvements

A Property Vicinity Map and Property Site Plan are attached to this report as **Figures 1 and 2**, respectively.



Structures

There are no structures on the Property.

Roads

There is a private asphalt-paved road that is a southern extension of Saratoga Creek Drive to the north of the Property. This road runs south through the west side of Lot 2, curves to the west around the bottom of Lot 1, then turns southerly to run a short distance along Saratoga Creek.

Mechanical Systems

There were no Mechanical systems observed at the Property.

Solid Waste And Sewage Disposal

Solid waste removal and recycling is available through West Valley Collection and Recycling. Sewage is available via City sewer lines.

Heating And Cooling Systems

There are no structures on the Property.

Source of Potable Water

Potable water to the premises can be provided through the municipal City supply service.

Hazardous Materials Storage, Use, Disposal

No hazardous materials were observed on the Property. There was no evidence of improper usage, storage, or disposal of hazardous waste or other chemicals noted at or on the Property.

Wells

There was no evidence of water supply, irrigation, oil, injection, or dry wells observed on the Property.

Interior and Exterior Drains And Sumps

No exterior storm drains or sumps were noted on the Property.

Storage Tanks

There were no above ground or evidence of underground storage tanks at or on the Property.

Stained Soil Or Pavement

There was no distressed vegetation or chemical staining noted in any of the areas on the Property or in any areas of exposed soils.

Current Uses of Adjoining Properties

- The Property is bound to its north by Legal, Dental, and Medical office complexes.
- The Property is bound to the south by vacant, undeveloped land.
- The Property is bound to its east by vacant land and a medical office facility.
- To the west of the Property is Saratoga Creek, across from which are single-family residences.

5) RECOGNIZED ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS

The goal of the processes established by the practice for conducting environmental site assessments is to identify recognized environmental conditions (REC's). Recognized environmental conditions indicate the presence or likely presence of any hazardous substances or petroleum products on a property under conditions that indicate an existing release, a past release, or a material threat of a release into structures on the Property or into the ground, ground water, or surface water of the Property. The term is not intended to include *de minimis* conditions that generally do not present a threat to human health or the environment and that generally would not be the subject of an enforcement action if brought to the attention of appropriate governmental agencies. Conditions determined to be *de minimis* are not recognized environmental conditions.

There were no RECs found during this Phase I ESA. Because the land was an orchard in the past, if sensitive-receptor occupancy is planned, soil sampling for OPCs and metals will be needed.

Phase-1 ES was not provided with any information regarding liens, activity and use limitations, specialized knowledge, or value reductions for environmental issues on the Property.

7) OWNER, PROPERTY MANAGER AND OCCUPANT INFORMATION

The Property is currently owned by the Client, Mr. Michael Sneider. The Property is vacant undeveloped land.

8) PREVIOUS ENVIRONMENTAL REPORTS

No previous environmental reports were provided nor were any on file with the researched regulatory agencies.

9) SITE RECONNAISSANCE

On October 28, 2016, Phase-1 ES conducted a visual reconnaissance of the Property.

9.1) Methodology and Limiting Conditions

Phase-1 ES inspected all physically accessible exterior areas of the Property during the site reconnaissance. Property photographs (**Appendix A**), site plans, and notes were taken during the reconnaissance.

9.2) General Site Setting

The Property is located in northeast Saratoga, California, approximately 22 miles to the east of the California coastline, about 8 miles to the west southwest of downtown San Jose, and about 10 miles due south of the southernmost tip of the San Francisco Bay. The surrounding areas consist of commercial and residential properties.

9.3) Exterior Observations

The exterior areas are primarily flat and covered mostly by short grasses, with some bare soil areas near the center of Lot 1. The soil is gravelly clays. There are several mature trees near the entrance of the Property off of Saratoga Creek Drive, and shrubbery and trees along the northern boundaries. There is one mature tree near the southeast corner of Lot 1. The asphalted road in the center between the two lots is in fair condition, with moderate cracking. There was no oil staining noted on the road. The road is fenced and gated near the southwest corner of Lot 1. There were no RECs noted on any areas of the Property, and no signs of hazardous materials usage, storage, or disposal on the Property. See **Appendix A** for Property photographs.

9.4) Interior Observations

There are no buildings or structures on the Property.

10) INTERVIEWS

The Property owner was not interviewed, as the Property has never been developed or had tenants in the past.

11) HISTORICAL RECORDS REVIEW FOR THE PROPERTY

Standards developed by ASTM E 1527-05 require that the history of a site be established from the present back to the time the Property was first used for residential, agricultural, commercial, industrial or governmental purposes, or back to 1940, whichever is earlier. Sources of such information are typically: interviews, aerial photographs, Sanborn Fire Insurance (Sanborn) Maps, historic city directories, topographical maps, and local fire, building and health department file reviews. Other historical sources include internet sites, community organizations, local libraries and historical societies, and current owner/occupants of neighboring property.

Phase-1 ES purchased a complete Environmental Database Report from MapHazardsPro, and reviewed available Topographical and Sanborn Maps, City Directories, and Historical Aerial Photographs. The following information is a compilation that comes from these reports, and agency files.

11.1) Historic Sanborn, Topographical Maps, and Aerial Photograph Reviews

No Sanborn maps covering the subject Property were available through Phase-1 ES sources.

APNs 389-06-020 and 389-06-021, Saratoga, California

Phase-1 ES reviewed low-altitude, black-and-white and color aerial photographs taken 1948, 1956, 1960, 1968, 1980, 1987, 1991, 1993, 1998, 2002, 2005, 2009, 2010, and 2012 to identify areas of possible environmental concerns related to previous land use at the Site or adjacent properties. Photographs were provided by Historical Aerials (NETR) and local sources. The observations from the aerial photographs of the Site and immediate vicinity are described below.

1948 & 1956 Aerial Photographs

The 1948 & 1956 aerial photographs show the Property and surrounding areas as what appear to be fruit tree orchards.

1960 Aerial Photograph (first noted development)

In 1960, the Property is still an orchard. Residential properties appear to the north across Cox Road. All other surrounding properties are either orchard or other agricultural lands.

No environmental concerns are noted.

1968 Aerial Photograph

The Property remains the same orchard in 1968. Developments are noted to the east and west. To the south remains orchards.

No environmental concerns noted.

1980 Aerial Photograph

In 1980, the orchard trees are removed from and surrounding the Property. The land is vacant. The private road through the Property now exists. Areas surrounding the Property are fully developed.

No environmental concerns noted.

1987 Aerial Photograph

The 1987 aerial remains similar to 1980 but now there are some non-orchard type trees on the property to the southwest. The commercial building due north of Lot 1 is now built.

No environmental concerns noted.

1991 - 2012 Aerial Photographs

The building to the north of Lot 2 is constructed in the 1991 aerial. In 1999 and 2002, there appears to be some kind of soil digging near the southern corner of Lot 1 – perhaps planting of trees. In 2005, the same area looks as if a tree is now growing. By 2009, the tree is grown, and remains noted in 2010 and 2012, as it is today.

No environmental concerns noted.

Topographical Map Overview

Phase-1 ES reviewed 22 Topographical maps related to the Subject Site from 1897 through 1995 to identify areas of possible environmental concerns, bodies of water and evidence of structures.

The Topographical Maps between 1897 & 1937 show no development closer than 500 feet of the Property. The first closer development shows up on the 1943 topographical map. In 1955, the entire area of and surrounding the Property is shown as a tree orchard. This remains the case through 1966. From 1969 and beyond, the orchards do not show on the topo maps. There is no shown development of the Property on any of the topo maps reviewed.

No environmental concerns were noted on any of the topographical maps.

11.2) Local Historic City Directory Review

City Directories have been published for major cities and towns across the United States since the 18th century. Originally, these Directories, published in the 20th century, also included a street index. For each

street address, the Directory lists the name of the resident or business operating from this address during a given year. City Directories are a valuable source of historical information as to site tenancy and use. Directories for rural areas were not often published.

City Directories were reviewed for nearby surrounding properties on Cox Avenue. None of the occupants listed historically operated businesses that would be of environmental concern to the Property.

11.3) Environmental Records File Reviews

Phase-1 ES obtained an environmental research database report by MapHazardsPro dated October 28, 2016 for the Property and surrounding sites. **The complete MHP report is attached in Appendix B of this ESA.**

11.4) Local Fire Department Records Review

The local Fire Department records were not reviewed, as is the Property has never been occupied or developed.

11.5) Local Building Department Records Review

Building Department records were not reviewed, as the Property has never been occupied or developed.

11.6) Local Health Department Records Review

Health Department records were not reviewed, as the Property has never been occupied or developed.

11.7) Additional File Reviews

The California GeoTracker database was researched for the Property. The GeoTracker Overview is shown on **Figure 6**. There are no records for the Property.

11.8) Document Data Gaps

ASTM Standard E 1527-13 requires the ESA report to note any data failure from historical research sources, if any; to give reasons why such sources were excluded; and discuss if data failure significantly affects the ability of the Environmental Professional to identify RECs for this ESI.

No data gaps were found. Records and reviews of historic data adequately documents land use and history from its first agricultural uses to present time, and all pertinent environmental information and records were obtained or reviewed.

12) REGULATORY AGENCY DATABASES REVIEW

ENVIRONMENTAL DATABASES SEARCH FOR THE PROPERTY AND SURROUNDING SITES WITHIN A ONE-MILE RADIUS

The following is extrapolated from an environmental research database report generated by MapHazardsPro on March 28, 2016 for the Property and surrounding sites. **The complete MHP report is contained in Appendix B of this ESA.**

12.1) List of Environmental Databases Reviewed

MapHazardsPro Radius Search Report

Searched Databases

NPL: National Priority List Sites

Sites which are found on the NPL database or the Proposed NPL database. NPL sites are a special category among National Superfund (CERCLA) Sites listed in the EPA's CERCLIS database. NPL sites are of serious, high concern and priority based on a national comparison to sites needing investigations and contamination cleanup activities (remediation). These sites, some of the worst in the nation, normally contain high levels of various contaminants that have spread over relatively long distances and usually require long term, highly expensive remediation technologies. Proposed NPL sites are of serious concern and are in the process of being evaluated for categorization as National Priority List sites. Delisted NPL sites have been removed (delisted) from the NPL if no further response or action is appropriate at the site, per EPA guidelines.

13) CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

After reviewing the pertinent vicinity environmental databases and history, it is our professional opinion that there are no sites in the vicinity of and including the Property that are of significant environmental concern. All of the sites listed are either; No Further Action Required, Closed cases, down or cross-gradient, soils only, or at too great a distance to be of any significant environmental concern to the Property. No violations were found for nearby hazardous waste generators.

The Property site inspection found no areas of chemically stained soils, distressed vegetation, or any signs of past or present hazardous materials usage, storage, or disposal anywhere on the Property.

Historic topographical maps and aerial photographs show and depict the Property as an orchard in 1948 through 1966. Organochlorine Pesticides (OCPs) were used in California's agricultural operations from 1944 through the mid-1970s. These hazardous pesticides and heavy metals were commonly used in agricultural operations during the time period the Property existed as an orchard. It is our understanding that the Property is being developed for sensitive-receptor occupancy. As such, the near surface soils should be sampled and tested in accordance with the California DTSC guidelines for previous agricultural properties. Based on the size of the Property, a total of at least 4 discrete samples are recommended to be collected from 0-6" below grade surface, and at a minimum, analyzed for OCPs and Arsenic.

This Phase I study has found no other areas of Recognized Environmental Conditions (RECs) associated with this Property.

No other environmental investigation is recommended to prepare the Property for development. Please see the Executive Summary of this report for additional comments regarding conclusions and recommendations.














