*P3a. Description: (Describe resource and its major elements, include design, material, condition, alterations, size, setting, and boundaries)

Typical of the early local National style, this two-story house has the distinctive proportions of a balloon-frame building, including a raised rectangular footprint, simple rectangular footprint, and moderately steep gabled roof line with shallow boxed eaves. Detailing dating from the era includes its reported redwood framing, its flat-board trim, and the proportions of the upper story. The house has large multi-paned windows around the entire house; many of these are alterations from the twentieth century. The walls are clad a variety of sidings: shiplap and clapboard, as well as vertical board and batten; the latter is on a shed-type addition at the corner of the house. The entrance porch has a small gable roof. Porches have been enclosed, and other minor alterations have taken place over time. Several outbuildings are also on the property.

The Jarboe House is listed on the Saratoga Heritage Resources Inventory, included as a part of HP-88-01. It qualified under Criteria a and c:

a) the property exemplifies and reflects special elements of the cultural, social, economic, aesthetic, and architectural history of Saratoga.

The Jarboe House also appears eligible for the California Register of Historical Resources under Criterion (3), as the house embodies the distinctive characteristics of the early National-style house-type from Saratoga's *Early American* period.



Historical Background

The residence was constructed in 1858 and was the residence of Henry Jarboe. Jarboe came to Saratoga in 1852 and was the town's first blacksmith. He was also an active community leader serving in 1863 as a member of a committee formed to survey and construct a road across the mountains to Santa Cruz. In that same year he was appointed one of six original trustees of the Madronia Cemetery Association. Jarboe also helped organize the first school in Saratoga. After Jarboe's ownership, the house was owned by Walter E. Herriman.

Integrity

Although altered over time with additions and some window replacements, the house retains adequate character-defining architectural design, workmanship and materials, as well a compatible setting and original location, and the property continues to represent the historic associations and feelings of this residence.
