

Heritage Lane is listed on the Saratoga Heritage Resources Inventory, included as a part of HP-19. It qualified under Criteria a, e, f, and g:

- e) the property embodies unique physical characteristics that represent an established and familiar visual feature of a neighborhood;
- f) the property represented a significant concentration or continuity of site or buildings unified by past development; and
- g) the property contributed to a unique natural setting constituting a distinct area having special character.

Heritage Lane has not been assessed for eligibility to the California Register of Historical Resources as a district.


